



Junior Classic 2009 - Fact Sheet

ENTRY TO THE TOURNAMENT

Entries must be on-line via the LTA website www.lta.org.uk (use the Competition Search link, event code SUR 106) and the deadline for acceptance is **1300 on Saturday 28th March 2009**. Entry fees must be sent to the Tournament Organiser at Westside LTC, 20 Woodhayes Road, Wimbledon SW19 4RF, and must be received by **Wednesday 1st April 2009**. Acknowledgement of entry will be by email. **There will be prizes for all events and all prizewinners are expected to be present on Finals' Day.**

THE DRAW

The draw will take place at 1800 on Monday 6th April 2009 in the Westside LTC clubhouse. If the tournament is oversubscribed, unsuccessful entrants will be advised **by Wednesday 1st April** at the latest.

MATCH TIMES AND ORDER OF PLAY

First match times will be published on the LTA website www.lta.org.uk by **Friday 10th April**, and subsequent draws and match times will be added daily during the tournament. (To view the draws and match times use the Competition Search on the LTA website, event code SUR106.) **It is the player's responsibility to check their match times.** Additionally, the initial draws and first match times will be published on the Westside LTA website, www.westsideltc.org.uk (follow the links to Junior Classic).

HOURS OF PLAY

Play will start at 0930 daily and go until dusk (and floodlights will be used if necessary). Competitors should sign in 15 minutes before their match time, be ready to play when the match is called and should not leave the Club without finding out their next match time. Prizewinners are expected to attend on Final's day.

COURTS AND BALLS

7 macadam, 3 porous acrylic and 2 artificial grass courts may be used. ITF approved balls will be used.

CLOTHING

Clothing should be at least **50%** predominantly white and non-marking shoes should be worn on court. Completely white clothing may be required for matches played indoors, so please ensure that these are available at short notice.

Light lunches and refreshments will be available daily.
