

Tournament Conditions of Entry

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the LTA and will be run in strict accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Tournament Regulations, including the LTA code of conduct.
2. Competitors may enter a maximum of two singles events and one doubles event. All Singles matches will be the best of three sets with a tie-break at 6-6 in all sets. For the Doubles events, the matches will be the best of three sets with a tiebreak at 6-6 in the first 2 sets. The third set will be a Match tie-break (first to 10 points). Competitors may be required to play in more than one match per day, particularly earlier in the week.
3. Singles events will be limited to a maximum entry of 64 players, and seedings will be based on a player's ratings/rankings at the time of the draw (or a lucky draw if relevant).
4. Every competitor must be a current member of the British Tennis Membership scheme, have a rating and agree to be subject to the Rules of the LTA (including, without limitation, the LTA's Anti-Doping Programme, the Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Procedures and the Regulations Concerning Match Fixing, Financial Speculation and Betting); also to fully and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction and authority of the LTA.
5. Every competitor must consent to the following:
 - participating in doping control procedures if selected, undertaken by a doping control officer by UK Sport.
 - being involved in any publicity connected with LTA Supported Tournaments, including media interviews, photographs and TV footage (please inform the Tournament Organiser if you are not happy with this).
 - the entry details provided being used to update the LTA's membership record of the person identified.
 - the LTA and/or the organizers of LTA tournaments, from the competitor's geographical area, using the entry details provided to communicate information about this and future tournaments via post/email or SMS.
6. **Entries must be on-line** and the deadline for acceptance is **1300 on Saturday 28th March 2009**. Entry fees must be sent to the Tournament Organiser at Westside LTC, 20 Woodhayes Road, Wimbledon SW19 4RF, and must be received by **Wednesday 1st April 2009**. Acknowledgement of entry will be by email. **There will be prizes for all events and all prizewinners are expected to be present on Finals' Day**.

7. **First match times** will be published on the LTA website www.lta.org.uk by **Friday 10th April**, and subsequent draws and match times will be added daily during the tournament. (To view the draws and match times use the Competition Search on the LTA website, event code SUR106.) **It is the player's responsibility to check their match times**. Additionally, the initial draws and first match times will be published on the Westside LTA website, www.westsideltc.org.uk (follow the links to Junior Classic).
8. If the tournament is oversubscribed, unsuccessful entrants will be advised by **Wednesday 1st April** at the latest. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason.
9. All Singles events will be run on a knock-out draw basis unless there are limited entries in which case a Round Robin format will be used. There will also be Consolation events for all Singles events (provided there are sufficient entries) and players are therefore guaranteed a minimum of two matches per event. The Doubles events will be a knock-out draw and a minimum of eight pairs will be required otherwise these events will not be run. The Doubles events will commence on Thursday 16th April.
10. No competitor will be allowed to play a match unless the appropriate entry fee has been paid. No player may withdraw from an event after the draw has been made except for injury, illness or personal emergency, and if no satisfactory explanation is received in writing within 48 hours, the LTA will be advised and ratings points may be deducted. Entry fees will not be refunded once the draw has been made. See the Fact Sheet for a provisional Order of Play.
11. A player who is absent when called to play during the tournament is liable to be scratched. Competitors must not enter two tournaments that run concurrently.
12. Westside LTC cannot accept responsibility for any injury or loss of property during the tournament, whatever the cause.
13. The Referee's decision will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. No complaint relating to the tournament will be considered by the committee unless lodged in writing with the tournament organizer within 48 hours of the cause of the complaint.
